

REGISTERED SHOOT RULES REFERENCE CARD

GUN SAFETY FIRST

- **ACTION OPEN** when not shooting. **LOAD ONLY** when in the shooting station.
- **KEEP GUN POINTED** down range at all times.

SQUADDING

- 2020 Circuit Shoots rules
 - **Minimum of 3 competitors.**
 - Spectators (non-shooters) cannot keep score for a squad.*
 - *EXCEPTION – A shooter who has completed the course that day **IS** allowed to trap for another squad.
 - If there are less than 3 competitors, a trapper from the host club is required.
- Fun shoots – minimum 3 competitors per squad
- **SHOW PAIRS** for that station are presented only to the 1st competitor in each squad.

SCORING

- **A HIT (dead bird) requires a visible piece (chip) to be seen from the target.***
Dust from a target does not constitute a hit.
- **NO BIRD:** A target which comes out broken or takes a totally different flight path than previous targets is a “no bird” and cannot be scored.*
- **REPORT PAIRS:**
 - **1st target a no bird** - Pair over with nothing established.
 - **2nd target a no bird** - 1st target established, pair is shot over to determine outcome of 2nd target.
- **TRUE PAIR SCORING:**
 - **Either of the targets ruled a no bird** - NOTHING IS ESTABLISHED.
 - Pair shot over to determine score outcome of both targets.
- **GUN MALFUNCTION:**
 - 3 gun malfunctions per registered shoot before shooter penalized.
 - 4th and additional malfunctions - targets shall be scored as LOST.*
- **SHOOTER MALFUNCTIONS:**
 - Example – safety left on or shooter fails to load the gun
 - Targets presented will be scored LOST

CLASSIFICATION: It is each shooter’s responsibility to keep track of their punches and to know what Class they are in at all times.*
